Data center space

- 112,000 sq. ft. data floor space

Power

- Total critical IT load: 32MW
- Two primary 34.5kV utility feeds, each rated at 60 MVA

- Generators with on-site fuel storage to support 24 hours run time at full load with 24x7x365 fuel delivery
- Power densities available up to 22kW per rack

- Dedicated modular chiller plant designed with a closed loop water cooling system for additional efficiency

- Dual interlocked nitrogen filled preaction dry pipe fire suppression system for vault areas

Chicago CH3 highlights



Design: CH3 was designed with a reinforced concrete slab floor that increases floor loading and variable rack densities. All doors in the data center are 10-ft. from arrival to vault allowing for unencumbered movements throughout the facility.

100+ security feeds: CH3 utilizes the Avigilon H4 Fisheye Camera line that offers a high-resolution, 360-degree view of the data center and provides realtime alerts to our in-house security team using pattern-based technology.
