Challenge #1 – Silos



22.7% believe that working in silos is one of the top barriers for enabling organizations to work effectively.

Challenge #2 – Skills



Only **50.5%** are confident about the skills that 'middle management and employees' have to embrace the digital opportunity.

52.0% 'Shaping new ways of working through organizational transformation' is the number one benefit that respondents have tangibly realized in the last 12 months

'Adjusting the culture to innovate and respond' is rated the third-least important factor to address.
